Postdoctoral Services

Engaging and Renewing a Postdoctoral Fellow

We provide information to PI's and postdoctoral fellows about university policies, best practices, minimum salary/stipend

Engaging an International Postdoctoral Fellow

We offer a low-cost access to UHIP while international postdocs wait for access to OHIP and we liaise with Labour Relations and Integrated HR to recruit and hire international postdocs.

Clarifying postdoctoral trainee vs. employee

We provide clarity on when a postdoc is a trainee rather than an employee, and when someone should be hired as a research associate rather than as a postdoctoral fellow.

Registering a Postdoctoral Fellow

We provide a portal and work with business officers to onboard new and returning postdoctoral fellows, including setting up benefits.

Supporting Postdoctoral Fellows

We provide information to PI's and postdocs on getting started, finding funding, understanding their contracts, finding other postdocs for community, professional development opportunities, and connecting to appropriate University policies.
